2. Title and Description of the works.

These will be put in the catalogue at the Committee's discretion.

## DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

All works need to be ready for display and the following items must be considered and acted upon by the artists PRIOR TO THE DELIVERY OF THE WORK.

Framed works/wall pieces must have hanging devices such as secured D-rings. With the use of hired melamine screens works cannot be permanently secured to the screens.

In view of time and resource constraints during the set-up phase of the Exhibition, should works be delivered "not ready for display or hanging", the Committee has the right not to display works.

Items that may require special attention to install and display, for example larger sculpture pieces, will in the first instance require the artist to contact Diane Millar at the TOBA Office on 9223 8132

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.

ART SALES

The Artist is aware that the Art Committee is acting as an agent for the artist.

The Art Committee will charge 30% commission.

Artists registered for GST must charge 10% GST on the sale price of the art.

Artists who have an ABN but are not registered for GST do not charge 10% GST on the sale price of the art.

Hobby Artists do not charge 10% GST on the sale price of the art.

Artists who have an ABN must supply the ABN to the Art Committee and advise whether they are registered or not for GST.

Hobby Artists must provide a signed 'Statement by a Supplier' form available from the ATO.

This annual Exhibition is a popular and highly anticipated event on the College calendar. It attracts a large and affluent audience and continues to benefit the College and artists alike.

Trinity College is a Catholic Boys' School in the Edmund Rice Tradition and a member of the Public Schools' Association. It has an extensive Old Boys' register which, together with the parents of current students and residents of adjacent areas such as the East Perth precinct, should provide us with an excellent forum in which to sell your artwork.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- The work must have been executed within the last twelve months and be the artists' original work.
- **Limits on the number of works per artist:**
  - 3 paintings
  - 3 sculptures
  - 5 ceramics or pottery
  - 5 pieces of handmade glassware
  - 10 pieces of handmade jewellery
- Fees must accompany the entry form. Cheques to be made payable to *Trinity College Old Boys' Association*.
- Weight for single pieces not to exceed 15kg and the maximum size of painting must not exceed 1.5m x 1m (including frame). Any variation to this must be discussed prior to delivery and is at the sole discretion of the Organiser/Committee.
- All paintings must be framed and/or presented with suitable hanging devices.
- Work must be clearly marked on the top left at the back with title, name, address, phone number, ABN (if applicable) and price (including 30% commission and GST if applicable).
- Exhibitor agrees to allow Trinity College Old Boys' Association to act as the agent for purposes of selling the Exhibitor's artworks at the 2010 Exhibition.
- If the Artist:
  - Has an ABN and is registered for GST, GST must be included in the sale price.
  - Has an ABN and is not registered for GST, GST does not need to be included in the sale price.
  - Does not have an ABN and deems themselves to be a hobbyist, they must provide a signed statement from the Taxation Department. Failure to do so will result in Trinity College withholding 46.5% of the sale price (forms available from Trinity College or the Taxation Department).

- The art will be insured by Trinity College while it is within the boundary of Trinity College.
- Insurance during transit to and from Trinity College will be the artist's responsibility.
- The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The awards will be announced by the President of TOBA (or his representative) at the award presentation on the opening night.
- There is limited hanging space so all works must arrive promptly at the assigned times.
- All works must be for sale. A 30% commission will be charged on all works sold during the Exhibition.
- Entrants are to allow reproduction of their work for publicity and promotional purposes only.
- Works not collected after one week of the closing of the Exhibition will become the property of Trinity College.
- Proceeds from your work will be paid within 30 days of receipt of your invoice.
- The total number of paintings for the Exhibition is limited to 300.
