The medical treatment Brendan underwent during his long battle with this illness has left him with severe physical impairments and he is now confined to a wheelchair. The Brendan Ryan Cup began in 2001 as a form of recognition for the fighting spirit shown by Brendan. Brendan is a remarkable Old Boy who continues to excel in life.

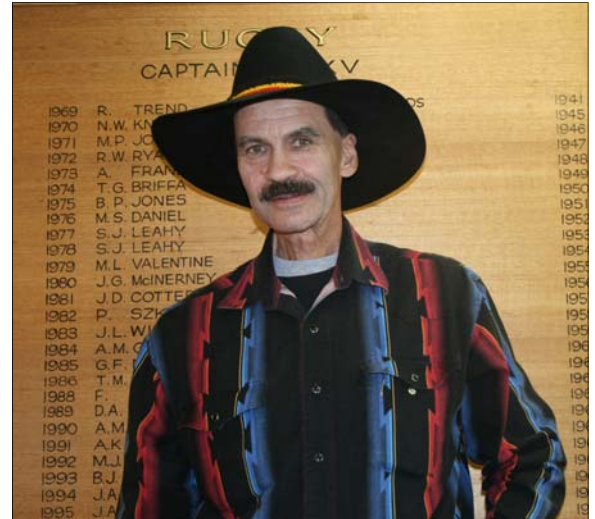

Inspired loyalty and dedication, smoothed ruffled tempers and supported the faint hearted. Team's performance is due in no small measure to his enthusiasm". These are qualities Jack has obviously carried into his life since attending Trinity, becoming a Solicitor, currently for the Gandangara Local Aboriginal Land Council in New South Wales. Jack was delighted to visit his old College for the first time since leaving in 1971 and meet with the Principal, Mr Banks and other staff members.
